Innovative Rail and Big Data Technologies Explored at Beijing <u>Jiaotong University</u>










Global Gateways: Outbound International Scholars in 2024















Global Financial Outlook: Navigating Student Expenses & International Expansion







Overall Internationalization funds

The bar chart illustrates a substantial rise in internationalization funds, increasing from 10.58 million PKR in 2023 to 116.40 million PKR in 2024, reflecting a major investment boost. This significant surge highlights a strategic focus on global expansion, partnerships, or international student programs. The sharp growth suggests an evolving commitment to enhancing global educational outreach and institutional competitiveness.

Internationalization funds from Austria





The comparative bar chart illustrates the sharp increase in education-related costs between 2023 and 2024, with tuition fees rising from 6.42 million PKR to 12.61 million PKR, more than doubling. Similarly, the monthly stipend surged from 1.05 million PKR to 5.35 million PKR, while airfare costs escalated from 0.92 million PKR to 4.28 million PKR. This significant rise suggests increased educational demand, inflationary pressures, or changes in funding policies.

Internationalization funds from PAF-IAST and Chinese Partner Universities

The stacked bar chart presents a breakdown of educational expenses, showing that tuition fees amount to 13.2 million PKR, while accommodation costs total 1.61 million PKR, bringing the overall expenditure to 14.81 million PKR. This visualization effectively highlights the proportion of costs, helping stakeholders assess financial distribution. The clear segmentation aids in better budget planning and decision-making regarding tuition and living expenses.





"Dr. Humaira Ayub Attends Genetics Festival Kickoff with Tribute at Anıtkabir in Ankara"



Prof. Dr. Serdar Ceylaner highlighted Turkey's advanced status in rare diseases research, emphasizing its global collaborations, diagnostic capabilities, and successful treatments. He stressed the need for investment in personalized medicine and youth-driven drug production to reduce dependency on costly imported treatments and further strengthen Turkey's role as a global leader in genetic research.


Expanding Global Horizons: PAF-IAST Students Thrive in Exchange Programs
